Re: CAN AM 2010 Weekend
Feb. 17 - 23, 2010 – Danvers, MA

Arrangements for traveling to Danvers, Massachusetts for the CAN AM weekend are now available. **You will require a passport.** The total cost for the bus trip will be \$170 per person. We will leave at 7:00 a.m., on Wed., Feb 17th, overnight in the Ramada Inn (\$69 plus tax 4 per room) in Bangor, then on to Danvers (\$109 per night) at the Sheraton Ferncroft Resort for Feb 18, 19, 20, departing on the 21st and overnight at the Fredericton Inn in Fredericton (\$79 Cdn. per night plus tax 4 per room) on the 21st, breakfast in a.m. for \$6.50 plus tax and gratuity) arriving home in Halifax on Feb. 22nd. After you book your room, I will need to know which members will be in your room with you to ensure everyone has booked a room so that I will know how many rooms are booked. We might get a free room for one of the drivers if we have booked 15 rooms enroute (not in Danvers though).

IMPORTANT: To reserve your space on the bus, we will require a deposit of \$85 anytime from now to October 15th, even if you have already put your name down to go, keeping in mind that your payment will make your reservation on a first cheques received first served basis since we may not be able to fill a second bus. The remainder will be due by December 1st after which time there will be no refunds. Cheques can be made payable to Gloria Turner. Anyone wanting to overnight in Halifax can go to the Holiday Inn Express on Kearney Lake Rd. where pickup will take place Wednesday morning at 7:00 am sharp! Those staying there will we hope be able to leave their vehicles until we return. This will be the only pick up for passengers in the South Shore/Halifax/Dartmouth/Valley areas. We will also pick up in Truro and in Aulac. Full arrangements will be forwarded to those who submit their partial payment.

The weekend meals in Danvers will be \$125 which includes Friday dinner buffet, Saturday breakfast, Saturday night banquet, and Sunday breakfast. The Exchange will have the exemplification of Degrees on Saturday afternoon. You will receive more information on activities and reservation forms in Danvers as it becomes available. The forms and information will be put on our Grand Chapter web site. If you do not have internet, you will need to contact me or your Chapter Secretary to obtain the forms to submit to the Danvers committee.

And as a reminder -- it takes several months to get a passport so you should apply for it early if you do not have one. When you send or give your cheque to me, I will require your full name, address, phone number, email address, and passport number as I am required to fax this information to Customs before our trip.
